MARLBOROUGH contains 19480 Acres, of which are 230 Acres of Water & 561 of Roads. There are 6 miles 315 rods of River, - 25 m. 193 r. of County Roads & 59 m. 258 r. of Town Roads. - Distance from State House, Boston 27 m. 160 r. - from Cambridge Court House 21 m. from Concord Court H. 16 m.
